Town of Tompkins Planning Board Meeting Thursday, September 13, 2012

The Planning Board for the Town of Tompkins met on Thursday, September 13, 2012. Those present: Paul Bartholomew, Sebastian D'Agati, Angela Porpora, Russell Thurston, and Kristin Janke-Schneider on behalf of Delaware County.

- 1. Kim Vargo from Cold Spring, NY appeared once again with regard to 1188 S. Dry Brook Road
 - Ms. Vargo presented a survey map showing the current properties and their combinations to make the 50 + acre parcel.

A motion was made by Paul Bartholomew and seconded by Sebastian D'Agati to classify the project as a Boundary Line Adjustment. The motion passed unanimously.

Paul Bartholomew will schedule a Public Hearing for Thursday, October 11th.

2. Kristen again went over the sub-division regulations as the PB suggested at the August meeting [Section 602 Paragraph E amended to include Mylar].

A motion was made by Sebastian D'Agati and seconded by Russell Thurston to send the revised Sub-Division Regulations to the Town of Tompkins Board for their approval. The motion passed unanimously.
