Highway Superintendent

- 1. Lots of plowing and grit has been laid on the roads due to the amount of snow we have had this winter. Residents need to understand that as things warm up and the ice and snow melts there is going to be a lot of mud and a lot of dust when things start drying out. They will try their best to take care of the issue when everything is dried out with sweeping.
- 2. The grit pile is extremely low due to the winter we have had and Ron wants to point out that to rebuild it, it is going to take all of the \$15,000 set aside for grit and then some.
- 3. Have had many issues with the furnace and after repair men coming 3 different times they had found it was an electrical issue with the boiler itself.
- 4. Repairs have been done on trucks
- 5. A letter was received from NY Central Mutual regarding the minor accident with the town truck and Seaman's vehicle, requesting reimbursement of apx \$700+ for what they had paid out to the Seaman's to have their vehicle repaired. It was discussed that before Bill went on vacation that he had approached Mr. Seaman and the Town was offering to cover their deductable but would require an estimate from 3 different repair shops, in which the Town has heard no more from Mr. Seaman. It was decided that the NY Central mutual will need to be contacted to see what is going on.
- 6. Ron stated he may purchase stone before April if the prices are lower than the prices for 2015.
- 7. Ron had Ben Funk come and look through the trucks he would like to replace. He was told they were in great shape and they should be between \$60,000 \$65,000 for them. Ron would like to get a new 1 Ton extended Cab (costing apx. \$50,000) and a new 10 Wheeler this year (costing apx \$228,000).

 After much discussion the Board asked Ron to come back to next month's meeting with more definite numbers before any decision was made.
- 8. Ron Discussed with the board the need to make some glorified driveways seasonal limit use roads. The Town is spending a lot of money and time to maintain these roads in the winter. Ron will look into the process.
